

## Equipment Hire Charges

These charges apply to use of club equipment outside of a club event. Liabilities for the use of this equipment are not covered by club insurance. Equipment hire is only available to qualified members, coaches, leaders or members attending approved courses. Non-members paddling with a member (as detailed above) may hire equipment. No hire charges for club sessions, trips or attending courses.

Insurance: Club members are only insured in respect of officially designated club activities. This means that activities not regulated or endorsed by the Club (including independent paddling) are NOT covered by the British Canoeing insurance policy. Individuals who require insurance cover for their paddling activities outside of official club sessions/trips/courses can obtain this by joining the Scottish Canoe Association as individual members.

### **Responsibility for ACC equipment**

All equipment is the responsibility of the person using it. ACC expects all members to pay due care and attention to the equipment they are responsible for. Members must return the equipment in the same state they received it.

Please check all equipment at the start of your hire. Any damaged or malfunctioning equipment must be reported immediately. If you notice any damage prior to your trip, please notify the club. In the case that any damage or loss has resulted from your hire, please bring this to the club's attention when you return the boat. Members will not be held responsible for reasonable wear and tear on equipment, but members who are responsible for loss or damage will be charged for repair or replacement of the item. Where equipment is lost or damaged the Club Committee will have the final decision over any charges incurred and will always aim to be fair and reasonable.

### **SMALL PRINT**

**Like all adventure activities, paddlesports carries a degree of risk. Equipment is hired entirely at your own risk. ACC cannot advise on weather conditions, river levels, the suitability of your plans or your paddling ability.**

In rare cases, bookings could be superseded by club activities.

The club retains the right to refuse hire.
