Coaching Edinburgh encourages coaches to embrace these responsibilities for the benefit of their participants, their sport and the wider community as a whole.



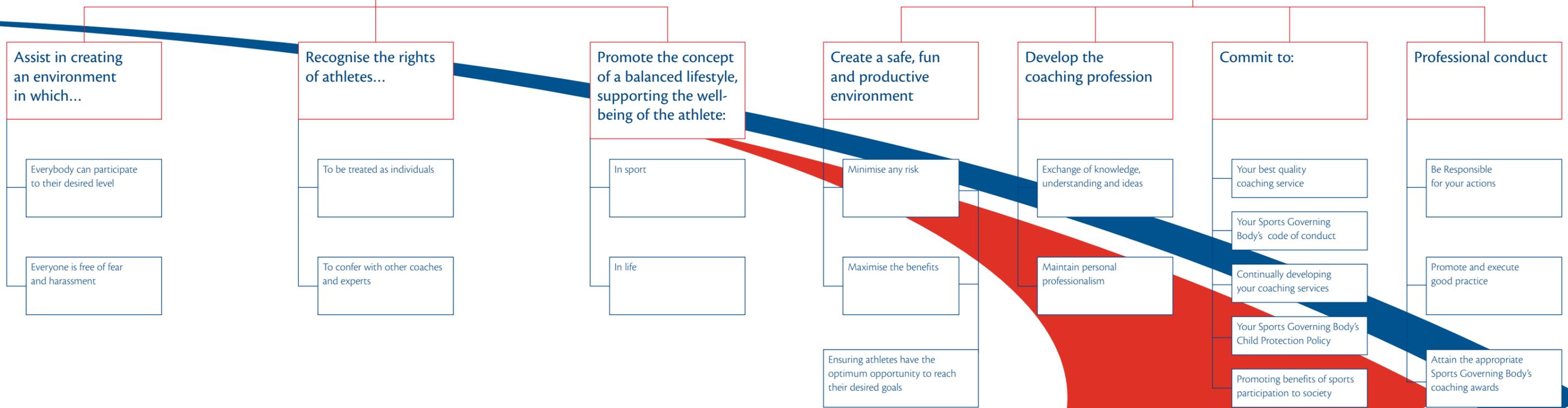

"Respect and champion the rights of every individual to participate in sport."

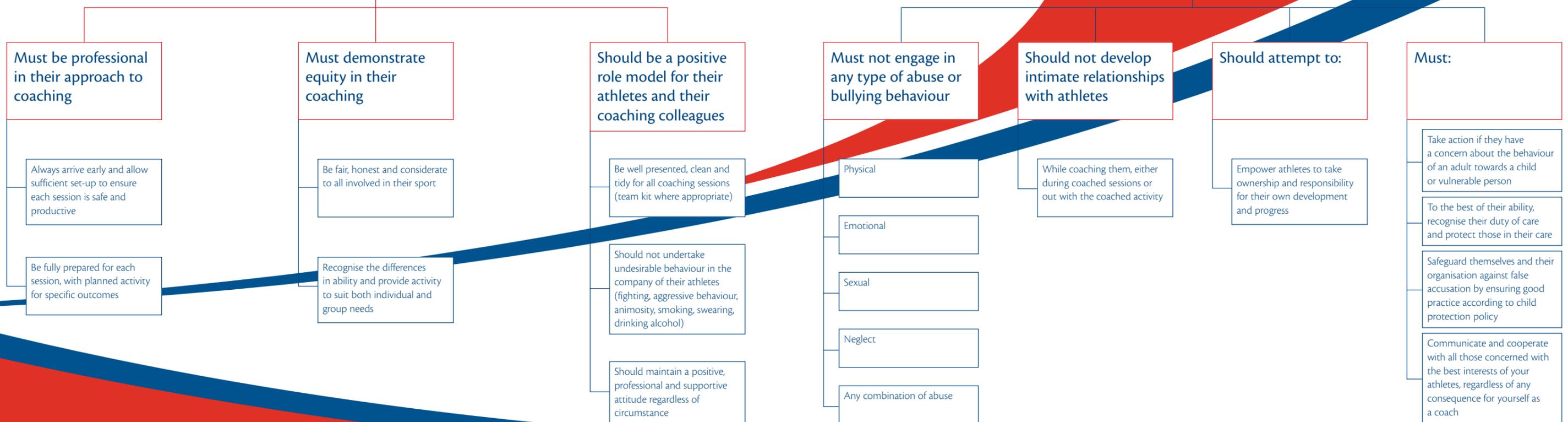
PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS
